



PRE-RECEPTION TEACHER (TO COVER MATERNITY LEAVE)

THE POST

Lichfield Cathedral School has a vacancy for a temporary full-time Pre-Reception Class Teacher from September 2009, teaching at the Junior School site in Longdon Green.

The successful applicant will deliver the EYFS curriculum to one of two Pre-Reception classes, as part of a friendly Early Years Team. The Nursery unit operates on a 1:6 ratio and the class will contain a maximum of 20 children. He/she will use the Staffordshire "My Story" profiles to assess pupils and inform planning. He/she will deliver information to parents through the form of a parents evening and be involved in the daily duties of the school.

THE SCHOOL

Lichfield Cathedral School is an independent co-educational School, currently for children aged 3 – 16.

Of the 460 pupils in the School, the majority attend on a daily basis, but full and weekly boarding facilities are available, presently only for boys. The boy choristers of Lichfield Cathedral are educated at the School as full boarders and a strong musical tradition exists.

Children aged 3 – 8 are educated at the Junior School in Longdon Green, and children aged 8 – 16 in the Middle and Senior Schools in the Cathedral Close.

The Headmaster is a member of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools, the Choir Schools Association and the National Association of Head Teachers. As a Cathedral School, it is expected that the teaching staff will be in sympathy with Christian principles and values.

STAFF DUTIES

All full-time members of the teaching staff share School duties on a rota basis which occasionally includes a day at the weekend.

APPLICATIONS

The successful applicant will understand that the appointment will be dependent upon the successful outcome of all normal employment checks, including through the Criminal Records Bureau.
