



## **BIOLOGY TEACHER (part-time)**

Lichfield Cathedral School seeks to appoint a part-time Teacher of Biology from September 2009 for the equivalent of 1 / 2 days per week.

The successful candidate will be:

- a person with initiative and drive;
- an enthusiastic and committed teacher, qualified to teach Biology;
- well informed in the teaching of Biology across the secondary years;
- confident in the use of Information Technology within the classroom and in administration; and
- resourceful in encouraging pupils to learn.

The successful candidate will be expected to:

- take responsibility for Biology within the GCSE Science curriculum in close consultation with the Head of Science;
- teach Biology in Years 9 – 11,
- prepare lessons with clear aims and objectives, encompassing a variety of teaching and learning styles;
- manage classes effectively, encouraging positive behaviour;
- provide progress reports to parents and conduct consultations; and
- conduct regular assessments and evaluations to inform future plans.

All teachers are expected to play a full part in the broader life of the school, including participation in the activities programme and undertaking some supervision duties, including occasionally at weekends. These duties are proportional for part-time members of staff.

Lichfield Cathedral School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children within the context of its Christian foundation and expects all staff to share this commitment.
